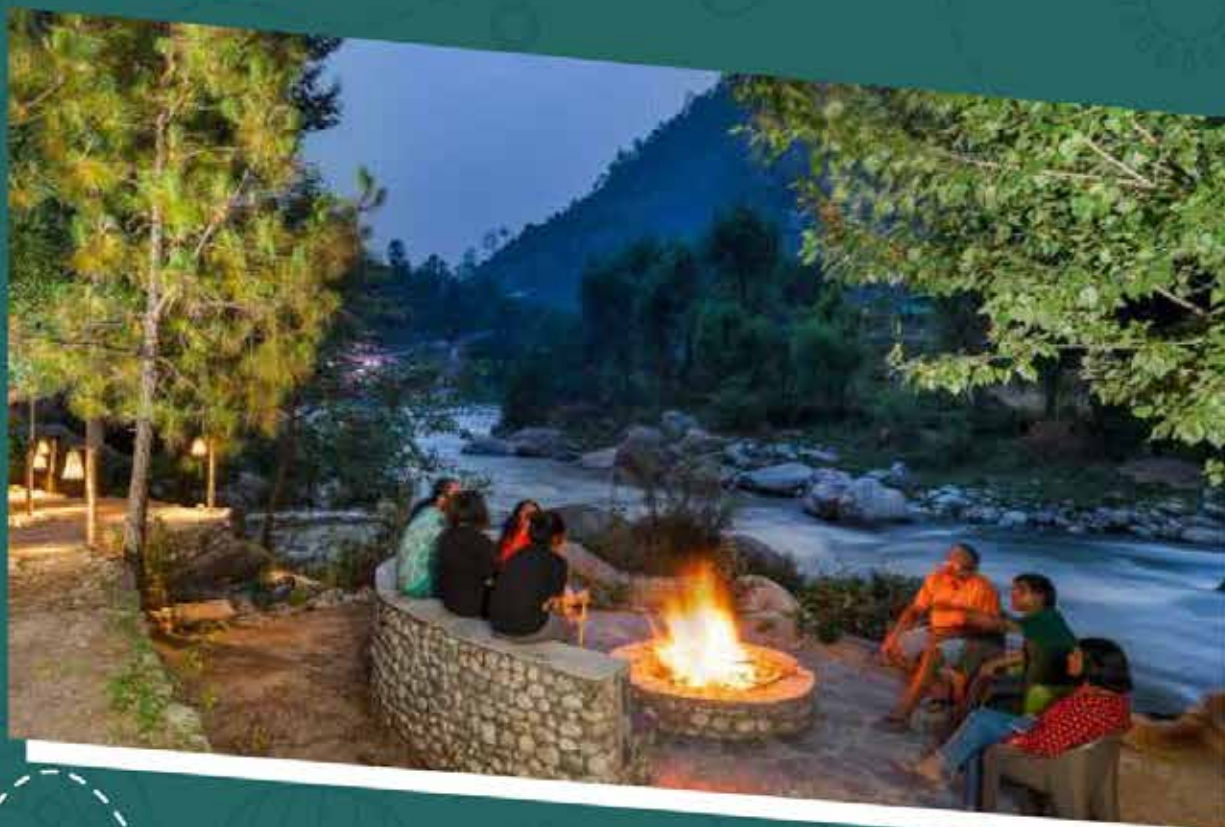

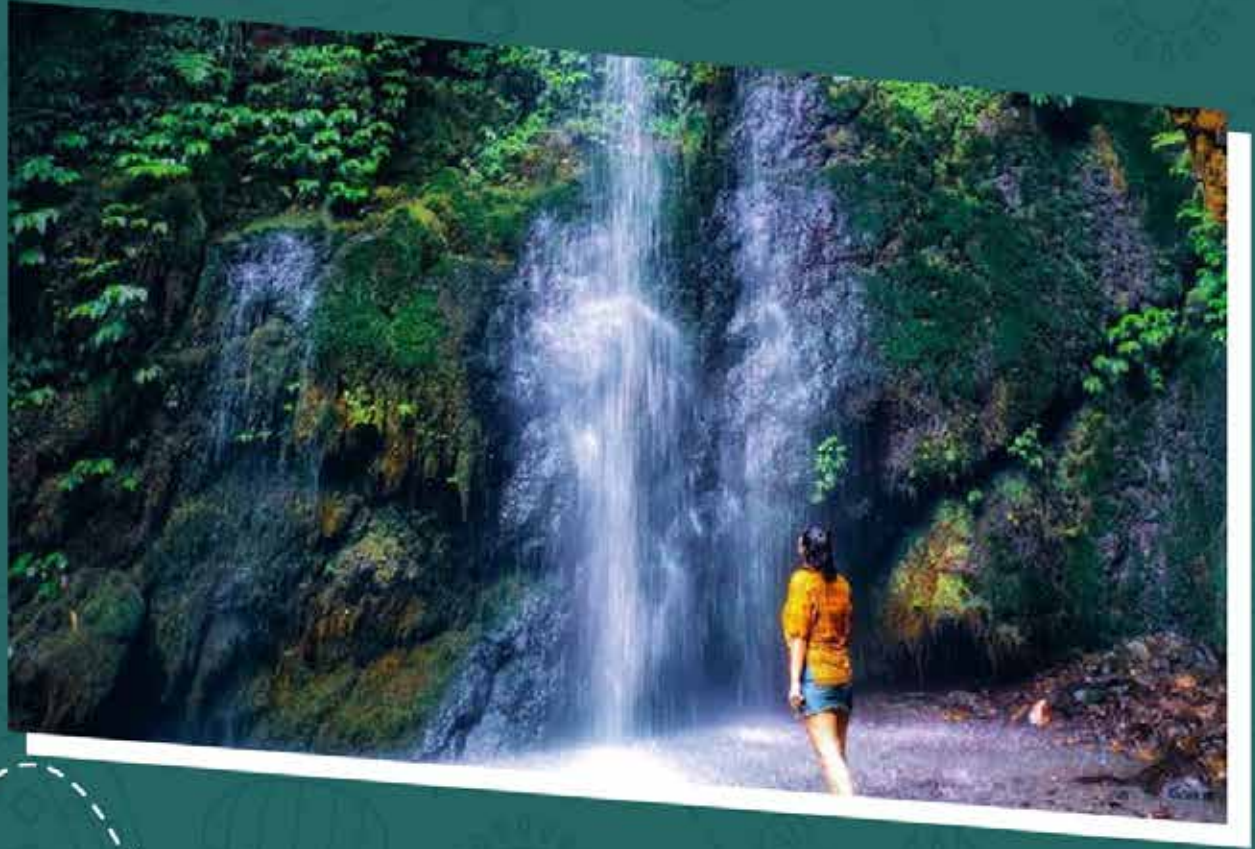
DAY 0
